Troparion — **Tone 4**

Thou wast enlightened by the words of Paul, O Thekla, <u>bride</u> of God; / And confirmed in the Faith by Peter, O divinely <u>cho</u>sen one. / Armed with the <u>Cross</u> of Christ, / Thou didst become the first martyr among <u>wo</u>men; / The wild beasts in the arena stood in <u>awe</u> of thee / As thou didst enter into the flames as though into a garden of <u>flo</u>wers. /// O praiseworthy protomartyr Thekla, intercede with Christ God that our <u>souls</u> may be saved!

First Kontakion — Tone 8

Thou wast a<u>dorned</u> with the <u>crown</u> of martyrdom, O Thekla most <u>glo</u>rious, / Shining forth with the <u>sple</u>ndor and <u>beau</u>ty of thy vir<u>gi</u>nity. / Thou didst en<u>trust</u> thy<u>self</u> to the words of Paul and the flames be<u>came</u> as dew, /// And thou didst vanguish the raging tyrant, O first woman martyr of the Lord.

Second Kontakion — Tone 2

Having been <u>wou</u>nded in thy heart with the <u>love</u> of Christ, / Thou didst spurn the transient <u>plea</u>sures of the flesh. / Thou didst re<u>ceive</u> enlightenment from the <u>cou</u>nsel of Paul, / And didst brave the wild beasts and bravely entered <u>i</u>nto the flames, /// O Thekla, the <u>glo</u>rious first woman <u>ma</u>rtyr of the Lord.
