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At "Lord I call...," 3 stichera, in Tone 4: To the melody, "Thou hast given a sign...."
Having received the grace of the All-holy Spirit /

The Father without beginning, the Source of the Divinity, /
And with Him the Son co-enthroned, /
One in essence with the Father, ///

By praising the mysteries of God with divine ecstasy. /
Therefore, having boldness before Christ, O hierarch Hierotheus, ///
Pray for the salvation of our souls.
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Now and ever..., Dogmatic Theotokion, in Tone 2:

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The shadow of the Law passed when grace came. /
As the bush burned, yet was not consumed, /
So the Virgin gave birth, yet remained a virgin. /
The Sun of Righteousness has risen instead of a pillar of flame! ///
Instead of Moses, Christ the salvation of our souls!
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Or the Stavrotheotokion, in the same Tone: To the melody "When from the tree...."

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Beholding Thee, her Lamb being voluntarily led to the <u>slaughter</u> / The caste ewe-lamb wept and <u>cried</u> aloud: /
"What dost thou <u>do</u>, striving to make me <u>childless</u>, O Christ, /
Who gave birth to Thee, the <u>Deliverer</u> of all? /
Yet I glorify Thine ineffable grace past all understanding, O Lover of <u>mankind</u>.
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Or Dogmatic Theotokion in the Tone of the Week if a Resurrection service.

The Aposticha is from the Octoechos.

The Troparion of the Martyr, in Tone 4:

Mastering the Good and being vigilant in <u>all</u> things, /
Thou wast clothed in the sacred beauty be<u>fitting</u> a priest; /
Having drawn ineffable Truths from the chosen <u>vessel</u> of God, /
Like Paul thou didst complete the course of thy life <u>keeping</u> the faith. ///
O holy Hierotheus, intercede with Christ God that He may <u>save</u> our souls.
