Vespers

At "Lord, I call...," 3 stichera, in Tone 8: *To the melody, "Standing before the tribunal...."*

<u>Thou</u> didst reveal thy holy hierarch to the <u>world</u>, O Lord, / As an heir to the apostles by both <u>words</u> and deeds, / And as a preacher of <u>O</u>rthodox <u>do</u>ctrine. / Therefore, he is truly a teacher of <u>hierarchs</u> /// And a participant of Thine incorrupt <u>glory</u>.

<u>Thou</u>, O Leo, wast a living pillar of the <u>Church</u> of Christ, / A preacher guarding the true <u>tea</u>chings of the Word. Now thou dost behold Him, the ever-a<u>bi</u>ding and e<u>te</u>rnal Truth / And thou dost glorify Him, the Lord and <u>Ma</u>ster of all /// Who hath so <u>glo</u>rified thee.

<u>Thou</u>, hast revealed the words of Thy hierarch <u>Le</u>o, O Lord, / To be a sharp sword of the Orthodox faith against the <u>i</u>mpious, / Cutting away the <u>fa</u>lsehood of their <u>tea</u>chings. /// Therefore, the wisdom of piety was increased in the world through him, O <u>Ma</u>ster.

Glory..., now and ever..., Theotokion in the same Tone: (and melody)

Behold, the groans of my contrite heart, O <u>Bride</u> of God; / Accept, O Virgin Mary, and reject not the lifting <u>up</u> of my hands, / O <u>pure</u>, unde<u>filed</u> one, / As thou lovest <u>goo</u>dness, / So that I may hymn and <u>glo</u>rify thee /// Who hast glorified our <u>hu</u>man race.

Or this Stavrotheotokion in the same Tone: (and melody)

Seeing her Lamb being led to the slaughter, / The ewe-lamb followed thee, O Word, weeping and crying aloud / "Where dost Thou hasten, O my child? / Let me come with you, my sweetest One! /// For I cannot endure to behold thee suffering, O most-merciful Jesus!"

Or Dogmatic Theotokion if a Resurrection service.

VENERABLE LEO, BISHOP OF CATANIA

The Troparion to the Saint, in Tone 4:

In truth thou wast revealed to thy flock as a <u>rule</u> of faith, A model of humility and teacher of <u>a</u>bstinence, / So thou didst win the heights of humility, riches by <u>poverty;</u> / O holy hierarch, father <u>Leo</u>, / Intercede with Christ our God to <u>save</u> our souls.
