#### TROPARION OF THE FEAST - Tone 4

Today is the preview of the good <u>will</u> of God / And the proclamation of the sal<u>va</u>tion of man: / The Virgin appears clearly in the <u>temple</u> of God, / And Christ is fore<u>told</u> to all. / To her, therefore, let us cry with mighty <u>voi</u>ces: / Rejoice, O thou ful<u>fi</u>llment /// Of the Creator's providence.

### TROPARION (St. Catherine) - Tone 4

O Jesus, Thy lamb <u>Ca</u>therine / Cries out to Thee with <u>great</u> love: / "O my Bridegroom, I <u>long</u> for Thee in pain, / I am crucified with Thee, and in baptism <u>bu</u>ried with Thee; / I suffer for Thy sake in order to <u>reign</u> with Thee, / I die for Thee in order to <u>live</u> in Thee. / Accept me as a spotless <u>vi</u>ctim / Since I am put to death because of my <u>love</u> for Thee." /// Through her prayers, O Merciful One, save our souls.

### TROPARION (St. Mercurius) - Tone 4

Thy holy martyr Mercurius, O Lord, /
Through his sufferings received his incorruptible crown from
 <u>Thee</u>, our God /
For having Thy strength he laid low his enemies /
And shattered the powerless boldness of <u>demons</u> ///
Through his intercessions, O Christ God, <u>save</u> our souls.

### KONTAKION (St. Catherine) - Tone 2

O ye <u>lovers</u> of the martyrs, form a <u>so</u>lemn rank / Divinely honoring the all-wise Catherine. / For <u>she</u> proclaimed Christ on the field of <u>ba</u>ttle / And trampled on the <u>se</u>rpent /// Ridiculing the knowledge of the eloquent.

# KONTAKION (St. Mercurius) - Tone 4

Let us glorify Mercurius with <u>hymns</u> of praise, / Blessing him as a victorious warrior in <u>ba</u>ttle, / And an unashamed helper in times of mis<u>fo</u>rtune, / Delivering from tribulations and every <u>so</u>rrow /// All who joyfully celebrate his holy memory.

# KONTAKION of the Feast - Tone 4

The most pure temple of the <u>Sa</u>vior, / The precious bridal chamber and <u>Vi</u>rgin, / The sacred treasure of the <u>glo</u>ry of God, / Is led today into the <u>house</u> of the Lord; / With her she brings the grace of the Holy <u>Spi</u>rit / Of her the angels of God <u>sing</u> in praise: /// "Truly she is the tabernacle of <u>hea</u>ven."
