KONDAKION - Tone 2

O all-holy Spyridon, enraptured by the love of Christ, /
Thou didst fly on the wings of the Spirit, /
To the pure contemplation which inspired thine apostolic life, /
And thou didst become an altar of sacrifice ///
Beseeching the Lod that He may enlighten us all
