## The 18th Day of February **Commemoration of our Father Among the Saints Leo the Great, Pope of Rome**

**Vespers** At "Lord, I call...," 3 stichera, in Tone 8: To the melody, "What shall I call thee?..." What shall we call thee, O divinely-inspired one? / Head of the Orthodox Church of Christ? / Discerning eye of piety, gazing with the wisdom of spiritual understanding / Shedding the word of life upon the ends of the earth? / Divinely inscribed scroll bearing the rule of faith? /// Pray, O father Leo, that our souls may be saved What shall we now call thee, O wondrous one? / Preacher of the truth and firm foundation of the faith? Elder of the honored assembly of hierarchs in heaven? / Most-excellent rule of doctrines divine, / Cutting through the division of Nestorius and the confusion of Eutychius /// With the divinely-forged sword of revelation. What shall we now call thee, O marvelous one? / Master or king over physical passions / Guiding all by the brilliant <u>light</u> of thy <u>spi</u>ritual strength? / Vessel of divine forgiveness? / Habitation of perfect love? Loving pastor awaiting the repentance of sinners? /// Pray, O father Leo, that our souls may be saved. Glory..., now and ever..., Theotokion in the same Tone: (and melody) Whom art thou emulating, O wretched soul? / One who never rises to repentance? / One not afraid of the fire awaiting the wicked? / Arise, and quickly call on her who is our lone defense, / And cry out: "O Virgin Mother! / Entreat thy Son and our God /// That He deliver my soul from the snare of the deceiver!"

#### **Or this Stavrotheotokion in the same Tone:**

When she beheld the Lamb /

#### 18 FEBRUARY

Stretched out by His own will upon the <u>Tree</u> of the Cross, / With maternal tears the <u>Ewe</u>-lamb <u>cried</u> aloud: / "Oh, my Son, what is this strange <u>sight</u> that I see? / How is it that Thou, Who giveth life to <u>all</u> as Lord, / Is put to <u>death</u>, O longsuffering One, / While granting the earthborn the resurrection? /// I glorify Thy great condescension, O my God!"

Or, on Friday or Saturday Evening, the Dogmatic Theotokion in the Tone of the Week.

## The Troparion of the Saint, Tone 8:

As an instructor of Orthodoxy, a teacher of piety and <u>purity</u>, / A lamp of the universe, and divinely-inspired enrichment of <u>hierarchs</u>, / O most-wise Leo, by thy teachings thou didst en<u>lighten all</u> /// O spirit-filled voice, beseech Christ God that our souls may be saved.
