 And called Thee His beloved Son. /

 Confirmed the truthfulness of His word. /
 O Christ, our God, who hast revealed Thyself ///
 And hast enlightened the world, glory to Thee.

TROPARION of the Martyr - Tone 4

Thy holy martyr Polyeuctus, O Lord, /
 Through his sufferings received his incorruptible crown from
Thee, our God /
 For having Thy strength he laid low his enemies /
 And shattered the powerless boldness of demons ///
 Through his intercessions, O Christ God, save our souls.

KONDAKION of the Martyr - Tone 4

When our Savior bowed His head in the River Jordan /
 He crushed the head of the serpent, ///
 And the severed head of Polyeuctus put the demons to shame.

KONDAKION of the Feast - Tone 4:

Today Thou hast appeared to the universe /
 And Thy Light, O Lord, has shone on us /
 Who with understanding praise Thee; /
 Thou hast come and revealed Thyself, ///
 O Light Unapproachable.
