TROPARION - Tone 3      (Apostle Philip)

O holy apostle Philip, /  
Intercede with our merciful God, /  
That He may grant to our souls ///  
The remission of our transgressions.

TROPARION - Tone 8      (St. Theóphanēs)

As an instructor of Orthodoxy, a teacher of piety and purity, /  
A lamp of the universe, and divinely-inspired enrichment of  
hierarchs, /  
O most-wise Theóphanēs, by thy teachings thou didst enlighten all, ///  
O spirit-filled voice, beseech Christ God to save our souls.

KONTAKION - Tone 2      (St. Theóphanēs)

Thundering forth the divine Incarnation of Christ, /  
Thou didst denounce the bodiless enemies, O wise Theóphanēs. /  
Therefore, we all cry out to thee with faith and piety: ///  
Pray thou without ceasing on behalf of us all.

KONTAKION - Tone 4      (Apostle Philip)

The first chosen of the apostles, Philip, /  
The most-wondrous fisher of nations, and converser with the  
apostles of Christ, /  
Bestows today a wealth of healing to the world, /  
And protects them that honor him from every calamity. ///  
Therefore with one voice we cry out to him: Save us by thy holy  
prayers, O apostle!
