Commemoration of the holy Martyrs Marcian and Martyrius, the Notaries.

Vespers

At "Lord I call...," 3 stichera, in Tone 4: To the melody, "As one valiant...."

O martyrs Marcian and Martyrius, / Having completed the course and having <u>kept</u> the faith / You received your crowns of <u>vi</u>ctory / For being unshakeable <u>pi</u>llars of the Church, / Vessels pouring forth the <u>milk</u> of Truth, / Luminous pearls, like lamps, enlightening all creation /// With the brightness of <u>pi</u>ety.

O divine friends united in <u>martyrdom</u>, / United in reason and in <u>one</u> accord, / You des<u>troyed</u> the division of <u>Arius</u> / Teaching that we must honor the Son as consubstantial with the <u>Fa</u>ther, / And equally co-eternal with the <u>Spi</u>rit, / Unity in Trinity and Trinity in <u>unity</u>, /// One nature undivided in three <u>Pe</u>rsons

O blessèd Marcian and Martyrius / You were followers of the great preacher, the arch<u>bi</u>shop Paul / And by the he<u>ro</u>ic shedding <u>of</u> your blood / You drowned the wicked <u>enemy</u> / And stopped the flow of evil <u>he</u>resy / With the streams of <u>pi</u>ety, /// Thus watering and refreshing the <u>Church</u> of Christ.

Glory..., in Tone 1: (by Germanus)

As the disciples and followers of the preacher and confessor Paul, / Who preached the consubstantial <u>Trinity</u>, / Together you suffered persecution with him / And preferred death by the sword than sub<u>mitting to heresy</u>. / <u>There</u>fore, you have been adorned by God with the crowns of <u>martyrdom</u> / And having great boldness before Him /// Intercede that He may deliver from danger all who honor your <u>memory</u>.

Now and ever..., Dogmatic Theotokion, in Tone 1, or this Stavrotheotokion, in

25 OCTOBER

the same Tone: To the melody, "O all-praised martyrs...."

As she be<u>held her Lamb upon</u> the Cross, / Bereft of form or <u>co</u>meliness, / The un<u>ble</u>mished Ewe-lamb, the sovereign Lady, cried la<u>me</u>nting: / "Woe is me! Where <u>hath Thy beauty fled?</u> / Where is Thy <u>sple</u>ndor, O most <u>Sweet</u> One? /// Where is the radiant grace of Thine image, O my most beloved Son?

Or Dogmatic Theotokion in the Tone of the Week if a Resurrection service.

The Aposticha from the Octoechos, then:

Glory..., in Tone 3:

O Marcian and Martyrius, / The spiritual lamps of the Church and champ'ons of the Holy <u>Tri</u>nity, / You drove back heresies with the <u>shield</u> of Faith / And enlightened the whole world with the light of <u>O</u>rthodoxy. / You were obedient to your pastor, the <u>bishop</u> Paul, / The equal-to-the-apostles and the teacher of true <u>do</u>ctrines, / And cast down the divisions of Arius and Nest<u>o</u>rius. / You spurned the confusion of Severus and Sa<u>bellius</u>, / Teaching the One unity of the Holy <u>Tri</u>nity, / God who came incarnate from the <u>Vi</u>rgin. / You sang the praises of one Christ in two <u>na</u>tures / Preaching Him to all in a pious <u>manner</u>, / Therefore, O all-praised and divinely-eloquent <u>mar</u>tyrs, / You have received your crowns of victory from <u>hea</u>ven. /// Pray that we be <u>granted great mer</u>cy!

Now and ever..., Theotokion, in Tone 3, or this Stavrotheotokion, in the same Tone:

A sword has pierced thine heart, O <u>pure</u> one, / When thou didst see thy Son up<u>on</u> the Cross; / And thou didst cry <u>out</u> to Him: / Leave me not alone and <u>childless</u>, / Who hath preserved me a Virgin after giving <u>birth</u> to Thee, /// O my <u>Son and</u> my God.

The Troparion of the Martyrs, in Tone 4:

Thy holy <u>ma</u>rtyrs, O Lord / Through their sufferings received their incorruptible crowns from <u>Thee</u>, our God. /

MARTYRS MARCIAN AND MARTYRIUS

For having Thy strength they laid low their <u>enemies</u> / And shattered the powerless boldness of <u>demons</u>. /// Through their intercessions, O Christ God, save our souls.

Matins

Two Canons from the Octoechos, and one of the Martyrs with 4 Troparia, having the acrostic: "I praise the two holy martyrs" (the composition of Joseph), in Tone 4 – incomplete as of 9/2915

The Kontakion of the Martyrs, Tone 4:

From your youth you have been <u>cha</u>mp'ons of the faith, / O Marcian and Mar<u>tyr</u>ius, / You vanquished Arius and his <u>he</u>resy / And kept perfect the faith by following in the footsteps of the arch<u>bi</u>shop Paul. /// Therefore you enjoy eternal life together with him, O defenders of the Holy Trinity.
