# Vespers

At "Lord, I call...," 3 stichera, in Tone 4: To the melody, "As one valiant among the martyrs...."

When the tribulations of the world laid hold of thee /

And the storm smote thy soul, O glorious one, /

Thou didst traverse, unharmed, the great abyss of torture

Steered by thine exalted name, as with a rudder, thou didst attain the harbor of <a href="heaven">heaven</a>

Where thou wast filled with ever<u>la</u>sting calm, ///

O martyr Thalelæus.

Lifted high upon a tree /

Thy sides cruelly slashed by savage torturers, /

Thou didst emulate the suffering of the Master of creation, /

And thou didst denounce their mistaken beliefs, O glorious one. /

Reviling the falsehood of idolatry, thou didst confirm the strength of <u>pi</u>ety, /// O martyr Thale<u>læ</u>us.

At the command of the tyrant /

Thou wast then cast into the <u>depths</u> of the sea, /

Yet, through divine grace, thou didst not drown, O martyr wise in God, /

But with the streams of thy blood didst thou drown the evil Pharaoh and all his army. /

Thus, strengthened by Christ, didst thou utterly de<u>stroy</u> him, /// O martyr Thalelæus.

[But if this day falls within the fast, the following stichera of the Theotokos are chanted *before* those of the Martyr, in the same Tone and melody.]

Keep me from evil transgressions /

That I be not condemned, O most holy <u>bride</u> of God, /

And through thy <u>prayers</u> deliver my humble <u>soul</u> from death; /

That I may receive justification on the Day of <u>Ju</u>dgment /

Which the assembly of the saints have already gained, /

And instruct me along the higher path which leads to salvation.

Seeing Thee the Lamb and Shepherd on the tree, /
The ewe-lamb who gave birth to Thee lamented, /
And as a mother cried out to Thee: /
"O desired Son, how art Thou hung on the Tree of the Cross, /
O Longsuffering One? /
How art Thy hands and feet nailed by the transgressors, O Word? /
How dost Thou shed Thy Blood, O Master?
Or Dogmatic Theotokion if a Resurrection service.
