# The 2<sup>nd</sup> Day of March Hieromartyr Theodotus, Bishop of Cyrenia.

### Vespers

At "Lord, I call...," 3 stichera, in Tone 4: To the melody, "As one valiant among the martyrs...."

Revealing thyself to be a most-<u>sa</u>cred priest, / An unshakeable pillar and very foun<u>da</u>tion of the Church, / A true <u>wo</u>nderworker given to us by God, O all-<u>glo</u>rious one; / And as a bright and <u>ho</u>ly lamp, / Thou didst acquire Jesus, the <u>Gi</u>ver of Life / And come to the Tree of Life in the middle of <u>Pa</u>radise, /// O hieromartyr Theo<u>do</u>tus.

Beaten with the sinews of <u>oxen</u>, / Shut in prison, thy feet cruelly <u>pierced</u> with nails, / Stretched <u>out</u> upon a <u>tree</u> and flayed, / Then placed upon a <u>fi</u>ery grill, / Thou revealed thyself untouched, O truly <u>wo</u>ndrous one, / Glorifying Him who gave thee strength to en<u>dure</u> all things, /// O hieromartyr Theo<u>do</u>tus.

Having crushed the enemy with the force of thy <u>struggles</u> / Thou didst destroy his power through thy courage, O <u>ra</u>diant one; / Coming to <u>dwell</u> in the kingdom with the victorious <u>martyrs</u>, on high, / Thou didst attain enlightenment rejoicing with them, / Ever praying for the salvation of those who <u>ho</u>nor thee, /// O Theodotus, glory of <u>martyrs</u>.

# Glory..., now and ever..., Theotokion, in the same Tone: (and melody)

Keep me from evil transgressions / That I be not condemned, O most holy <u>bride</u> of God, / And through thy <u>prayers</u> deliver my humble <u>soul</u> from death; / That I may receive justification on the Day of <u>Judgment</u> / Which the assembly of the saints have al<u>rea</u>dy gained, / And show me cleansed through my tears and re<u>pentance</u> /// Before the <u>coming</u> of the end.

### **Or the Stavrotheotokion, in the same Tone:** (and melody)

Seeing Thee nailed to the Cross, O Lord, /

#### 2 MARCH

The ewe-lamb, Thy Mother, cried out in a<u>ma</u>zement: / "<u>What</u> is this sight, O Most-de<u>si</u>red Son? / What has the ungrateful assembly <u>done</u> to Thee / Having once delighted themselves in Thy many <u>mi</u>racles? /// But I glorify Thy ineffable condescension, O <u>Ma</u>ster!"

Or Dogmatic Theotokion if a Resurrection service.

#### **General Troparion of a Martyr, in Tone 4:** (None given in the Menaion)

Thy holy martyr Theo<u>do</u>tus, O Lord, / Through his sufferings received his incorruptible crowns from <u>Thee</u>, our God / For having Thy strength he laid low his <u>en</u>emies / And shattered the powerless boldness of <u>de</u>mons /// Through his intercessions, O Christ God, <u>save</u> our souls.

By exposing the seas of <u>false</u> belief / Thou didst capsize the godless pride of <u>idolatry</u> / Through the strength of the <u>O</u>rthodox faith, / Becoming thyself a burnt <u>o</u>ffering to the Lord / Showering thy miracles now upon the earth, / O holy hierarch, father Theo<u>do</u>tus, /// Pray Christ God that He grant us great mercy.
