Holy Martyrs Terence, Pompeius, Africanus, Maximus, Zeno, Alexander, Theodore, Macarius, and 33 others beheaded at Carthage.

Vespers

At "Lord, I call...," 3 stichera, in Tone 4:

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The numerous and glorious company of <u>martyrs</u> / Courageously endured great <u>torments</u> / And went rejoicing to our <u>One</u> God, / Making glad with the host of angelic <u>powers</u>; / For they fearlessly vanquished the host of <u>vipers</u> /// By the Grace of the Holy <u>Spi</u>rit.
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Let us praise in song the most glorious <u>Maximus</u>, / Great Térence, and Pom<u>pei</u>us the wise, / The godly Ma<u>carius</u> and Afri<u>canus</u> / And with them the rest of the martyred <u>company</u>, / By whose own blood they purchased the <u>kingdom</u> on high /// And attained the heights of <u>glory</u>.

Neither starvation, nor mis<u>fo</u>rtune; /
Neither life, nor death was able to separate you, O <u>glo</u>rious ones, /
From the <u>love</u> which you have towards Him who created you. /
Therefore you inherited the kingdom of <u>heaven</u> /
And its eternal joy and <u>swee</u>tness. ///
And we pray: entreat for us the cleansing of our sins and great <u>mercy</u>.

Glory..., now and ever..., Theotokion, in the same Tone:

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Containing within thy womb the uncontainable God, / Who, in His love for mankind became a man / And accepted from thee the substance of our flesh / Thus deifying our nature, / Do not disdain me, O All-pure one, in my sorrow. / But come quickly and take pity on me /// And release me from the harm and enmity of the evil one.
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Or the Stavrotheotokion, in the same Tone:

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Seeing Thee the Lamb and <u>Shepherd</u> on the tree, / The ewe-lamb who gave birth to Thee lamented, /
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10 APRIL

And as a <u>mo</u>ther cried <u>out</u> to Thee: /
"O desired Son, how art Thou hung on the <u>Tree</u> of the Cross, /
O Longsuffering One? /
How art Thy hands and feet nailed by the transgressors, O Word? /
How dost Thou shed Thy Blood, O Master?

The General Troparion of the Martyrs, in Tone 4: (No Troparion of the Saints given in the Menaion)

Thy holy martyrs, O Lord, /

Through their sufferings received their incorruptible crowns from <u>Thee</u>, our God / For having Thy strength they laid low their enemies /

And shattered the powerless boldness of demons ///

Through their intercessions, O Christ God, save our souls.

After the third Ode, the Sessional Hymn of the Saints, in Tone 4: To the melody, "Having been lifted up...."

The forty-one passion-<u>bear</u>ers of Christ, /
Armed only by His <u>po</u>wer /
De<u>fea</u>ted the horde of demons <u>by</u> their faith, /
And dying, they passed over to eternal life, re<u>joi</u>cing ///
And they ever pray for the remission of sins for us who celebrate their <u>vic</u>tory.

Glory..., now and ever..., Theotokion, in the same Tone:

Though I am enamored by my sin, /
Yet do I beseech thee, O most pure Lady, /
Who gave birth to the sinless God: /
Take pity on my sinful soul /
And cleanse me from my many transgressions, ///
For thou art the purification, help and salvation of the faithful.

Or the Stavrotheotokion, in the same Tone:

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She, who in these <u>lat</u>ter days /
Gave birth in the flesh to Thee, begotten of the unoriginate <u>Fa</u>ther, /
Cried <u>out</u> beholding Thee upon the Cross: /
"Woe is me, O most belovèd Jesus, /
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MARTYRS TERENCE, POMPEIUS, AFRICANUS AND OTHERS

How is it that Thou Who art glorified as God by the <u>angels</u> / Art now crucified of Thine own will by the transgressing <u>people?</u> /// Yet do I praise Thy Longsuffering, O Christ.'

After the Sixth Ode, the Kontakion of the Martyrs, in Tone 2: *To the melody, "The Theotokos, who is ever vigilant..."*

Today we honor the precious <u>me</u>mory /
Of the martyr Terence the wise, and his forty com<u>panions</u>. /
Let us <u>gather together and worthily rejoice /</u>
That we may receive the gift of <u>healing</u>; /
For <u>they</u> have received from God the grace of the Holy <u>Spi</u>rit ///
For healing the in<u>fi</u>rmities <u>of</u> our souls.

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
