TROPARION (Ven Symeon)- Tone 1

TROPARION (Ven Nikita)- Tone 4

And possessing a courageous character, /  
Thou didst defeat the enemy  
And proven pleasing to God with thy wisdom.  
Thou didst receive the gift of working miracles from Him: /  
The casting out of demons and the healing of the sick. ///  
O most-glorious Nikita, beseech Christ God that He may save our  
souls.

KONDAKION (Ven Simeon) - Tone 2

Desiring to attain the things on high /  
Thou didst abandon the things below /  
And didst fashion a pillar like unto heaven. /  
By this, shining forth with the light of miracles ///  
And praying for us to Christ the God of all.

KONDAKION (Ven Nikita) - Tone 2

Thou didst receive the crown of incorruption from the hands of  
Christ /

For thou didst necessarily suffer death for His sake at the  
hands of thy servants. /

And now, thou dost grant healing to all /

Who come to thy holy shrine with faith, ///

O ven'erable Nikita, the intercessor for our souls.
