TROPARION (Monk Martyr Anastasius) - Tone 4

Thy martyr Anastasius, O Lord, /

Through his sufferings received his incorruptible crown from <u>Thee</u>, our God. / For having Thy strength he laid low his <u>enemies</u> / And shattered the powerless boldness of <u>demons</u> /// Through his intercessions, O Christ God, save our souls.

KONTAKION (Both Saints) - Tone 1:

Come, O ye <u>fai</u>thful, and let us praise Timothy the holy a<u>po</u>stle / The companion of Paul in his <u>tra</u>vels; / And to<u>ge</u>ther with him, let us honor the wise Ana<u>sta</u>sius / Who came from <u>Pe</u>rsia like a star /// For the healing of our souls' passions and our bodies' di<u>sea</u>ses.
