## At "Lord, I call...," 3 stichera, in Tone 8: To the melody, "Thy martyrs...."

Attending to the sweet words of the Divine Spirit, / O sweet Gly<u>ke</u>ria, / Thou didst abandon the bitterness of <u>carnal passions</u>, / And through death hast thou passed over to eternal <u>glory</u>, /// Entreating Christ to grant His great <u>mercy</u> on us.

Gly<u>ke</u>ria was wounded with sweetness of Thy love, O <u>Ma</u>ster, / And endured the bitter pain of suffering <u>for</u> Thy sake. / Therefore, she now rests in <u>ble</u>ssed and <u>pa</u>inless repose / And rejoices in a place of purity and incor<u>ruption</u>. /// Through her prayer, O Word of God, grant Thy great <u>me</u>rcy on us.

<u>Bra</u>vely confessing the name of Christ thy <u>Bri</u>degroom, / In the presence of the lawless <u>enemy</u>, / Thou wast condemned under the law, to <u>suffer for</u> His sake. / Sentenced to be torn apart by wild <u>beasts</u> / Courageously didst thou vanquish them all, O most <u>ho</u>nored one. /// Entreat Christ now that He grant His great mercy on us.

### **Troparion of the Saint, in Tone 4:**

O Jesus, Thy lamb Gly<u>ke</u>ria / Cries out to Thee with <u>great</u> love: / "O my Bridegroom, I <u>long</u> for Thee in pain, / I am crucified with Thee, and in baptism <u>bu</u>ried with Thee; / I suffer for Thy sake in order to <u>reign</u> with Thee, / I die for Thee in order to <u>live</u> in Thee. / Accept me as a spotless <u>victim</u> / Since I am put to death because of my <u>love</u> for Thee." /// Through her prayers, O Merciful One, <u>save</u> our souls.
