Martyr Lucian

TROPARION (St. Euthymius) - Tone 8

The image of God was truly preserved in thee, O father, /
For thou didst take up thy cross and follow Christ /
By so doing thou didst teach us to disregard the flesh, for
it passes away /
But to care instead for the soul, since it is immortal ///
Therefore thy spirit, O holy Euthymius, rejoices with the angels.

TROPARION (St. Lucian) - Tone 4

Thy holy martyr Lucian, O Lord, /
Through his sufferings received his incorruptible crown from Thee,
our God /
For having Thy strength he laid low his enemies /
And shattered the powerless boldness of demons ///
Through his intercessions, O Christ God, save our souls.

Let us honor with hymns of praise /
Lucian, the most splendid luminary of the Church, /
Who shone forth in fasting and abstinence /
And later was radiant in his suffering, ///
As he ceaselessly prays now for us all.

Thou didst drown the bodiless enemy with the mighty streams of
thy tears, /
And having received the gift of working miracles /
Thou dost heal the pain of all who come to thee in distress. ///
