The fiery tongue of thy <u>teachings</u> / Has burned to ashes the debris of <u>he</u>resy, / And the <u>a</u>rmies of the impious who would not ac<u>cept</u> the truth / Have been drowned in the depths of thy knowledge and under<u>standing</u>, / O holy father <u>Cy</u>ril. / The Church of the faithful is therefore adorned with thy beautiful <u>do</u>ctrines /// And she honors thee with mighty <u>voices</u>! (twice)

Glory..., in Tone 6:

O good and faithful <u>se</u>rvant, / Fervent worker in the <u>vi</u>neyard of Christ, / Bearing thy burden, thou didst increase the talents <u>gi</u>ven thee / And did not forsake those who <u>fo</u>llowed thee. / Therefore the gates of the heavenly kingdom were <u>o</u>pened to thee / And thou didst enter into the joy of <u>Christ</u> the Lord. /// Entreat Him on our behalf, O holy father <u>Cy</u>ril.

9 JUNE

Beholding her Lamb up<u>on</u> the Cross, / The unblemished ewe-lamb, the immaculate <u>La</u>dy, / Cried out in maternal a<u>maze</u>ment: / "What is this new and all-glorious <u>won</u>der, / O my <u>Sweet</u>est Child? / How hath this ungrateful assembly betrayed Thee to <u>Pi</u>late, / And condemn Thee to death, the <u>Life</u> of all? /// Yet do I praise Thine ineffable conde<u>scen</u>sion, O Word!"

Beholding Thee <u>cru</u>cified, O Christ / She who gave Thee birth cried <u>out</u> to <u>Thee</u>: / "What is this strange mystery I <u>see</u>, my Son? / How, being hung in the flesh, the <u>Giver of Life</u>, /// Dost Thou <u>die</u> on the Tree?"

The Troparion for St. Cyril, in Tone 8:

As an instructor of Orthodoxy, a teacher of piety and <u>pu</u>rity, / A lamp of the universe, and divinely-inspired enrichment of <u>hi</u>erarchs, / O most-wise Cyril, by thy teachings thou didst en<u>lighten all</u> /// O spirit-filled voice beseech Christ God to <u>save</u> our souls.
