TROPARION (St. Phocas) - Tone 4

Like the apostles in <u>cha</u>racter, /

KONTAKION (St. Quadratus) - Tone 8

The universe brings to thee the apostle Quad<u>ra</u>tus / As an hon'rable hierarch and a brave <u>martyr</u>, O Lord, / And with hymns it honors his precious <u>memory</u>, / For he is ever praying for the re<u>mi</u>ssion of sins /// Of us who sing his praises, O greatly-merciful One.
