

Troparion of the Martyrs - in Tone 4:

Thy martyrs Onesiphórus and Porphyrius, O Lord, /
Through their sufferings received their incorruptible crowns from
Thee, our God /
For having Thy strength they laid low their enemies /
And shattered the powerless boldness of demons ///
Through their intercessions, O Christ God, save our souls.

Troparion of the Ven. Matrona - in Tone 8:

The image of God was truly preserved in thee, O Mother, /
For thou didst take up thy cross and follow Christ /
By so doing thou didst teach us to disregard the flesh, for it
passes away /
But to care instead for the soul, since it is immortal ///
Therefore thy spirit, O venerable Matrona, rejoices with the angels.

Kontakion of the Ven. Matrona - in Tone 2:

For the sake of thy love for the Lord /
Thou didst despise a life of ease, O Matrona. /
Thou didst illumine thy spirit with fasting /
And through thy prayers cast down the arrogance of the demons ///
Mightily destroying the enemy.

Kontakion of the Martyrs - in Tone 2:

Having suffered greatly for the Lord, /
The two martyrs cast down the pride of the enemy. /
And being illumined by the grace of the uncreated Trinity /
The glorious Onesíphorus and Porphyrius ///
Ceaselessly pray on behalf of us all.
